

INCIDENTI SUI CAMPI DI GIOCO E RESPONSABILITÀ OGGETTIVA DELLE SOCIETÀ DI PALLACANESTRO

ABSTRACT: The author analyzes a decision of the National Sports Judge of the Italian Basketball Federation concerning the causes of a basketball match suspension due to an athlete's illegal attitude.

A player, after having been ejected by referees, kicked and broke a bottle of oil for health massages, which sprawled on the parquet, making the pitch inadequate for the match continuation.

The first Judge acknowledged the responsibility of the club and decided to repeat the competition.

Subsequently, however, the Sports Court of Appeal of the Italian Basketball Federation rejected the decision of first instance, holding the relevant club as responsible for the behavior of his player, and it has finally condemned the club to the defeat for 0-20.
